

- Results of the Public Process
 - Community split between free flowing river and maintaining the pond
 - One alternative stood out as an overwhelming second-choice alternative
 - Led to the establishment of a joint agency oversight committee comprised of community decision-makers
- Mirror Pond Ad Hoc Committee




