Measure Description:

Reorganizes mission and governance of State Library.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Judicial Department, Secretary of State, Oregon State Library

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Consumer Protection and Government Effectiveness to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill modifies laws relating to the Oregon State Library (OSL). The bill articulates the mission and duties of OSL and requires OSL to report each biennium to the Legislature and the Department of Administrative Services on the effectiveness of services. The bill also makes other changes to the governance, responsibilities, and operations of the agency. It is anticipated that there is a fiscal impact associated with this bill, but the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is further considered.
