I decided 63 years ago - after serving honorably in the U.S. Army - to never again carry or possess a firearm.

Experiences during the Korean war, when 36, 574 of my military compatriots died, convinced me that guns serve no purpose other than to kill.

The Koteam causality figures pale by comparison to gun deaths in America now. On average EVERY YEAR in the United States nearly as many men, women and children, 32,500, as were killed during three years of war in Korea die by gunfire.

Ee are awash in guns. There are now almost as many guns as their are people in this country. And sales continue to rise. More guns, more deaths,

So it makes sense to support measures that attempt to control sales of firearms; to help keep guns out if the hands of bad guys.

SB 942 does that.
