I urge a no vote on Senate Bill 941.

I agree that a background check should be done when a person sells a firearm to another person either personally or at a gun show.

I would not want to sell one of my firearms to a person without a background check.

However, Bill 941 is too restrictive and goes to far and must be amended.

I take all my guns to my son for safe keeping when I go on vacation.

If 941 is passes, as it stands, if I understand correctly, it would be illegal for me to do so.

That is bad. We must be able to do a private transfer if we need to legally.

If bill 941 passes I would have to go to a dealer and transfer all my firearms.

Again, I support this bill but it should be amended to read "the sale" of a firearm.

Temporary transfers should not be part of the legislation.
