**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Repeals outdated and obsolete provisions and updates references related to human services programs. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

**BACKGROUND:** In 2014, the Legislature passed House Bill 4133 directing the Office of Legislative Counsel (LC) and the Department of Justice to review statutes each biennium to identify outdated, obsolete and duplicative language. LC may then prepare measures to repeal or update language, at its discretion. If LC determines to draft measures to update or repeal existing laws, it must also prepare an explanatory report to accompany each measure, for distribution to legislators and the public 90 days before the start of each legislative session in an odd-numbered year.

House Bill 2913 is one of a series of measures this session prepared by LC pursuant to House Bill 4133 (2014). It repeals obsolete laws relating to human services programs.
