






HB 2449A Overview

Pilot

- Incentivizes bio-energy production
- \$15 million cap per biennium
- Electricity, anaerobic digestion and thermal energy
- Competitive selection favoring new capacity

Existing program

- Updates credit rates for used oil and manure
- Adds credit rates for food processing residues and food waste
- Authorizes ODOE to update rates


<u>Sunset</u>

- Extends sunset from 2017 to 2021
- Early extension proposed to address stakeholder concerns






Biomass Producer or Collector Tax Credit
