Construction Contractors Board

HB 5011 is the budget bill for the Construction Contractors Board. CCB regulates the profession of construction contracting through licensing and disciplinary programs. It provides dispute resolution services, investigates complaints, and imposes fines for violations of Oregon laws. The agency is funded with revenue generated from license fees.

The General Government Subcommittee recommends a budget of \$14,772,368 Other Funds and 62 positions, or 62.00 full-time equivalent jobs. This recommendation eliminates seven positions that are currently vacant, and reduces Other Funds limitation by \$1,056,806. The ending fund balance is budgeted at \$2,098,992 and equates to roughly 3.4 months of expenditures.

The Subcommittee also recommends adoption of Key Performance Measures as presented.

The General Government Subcommittee recommends HB 5011 be amended by the -1 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
