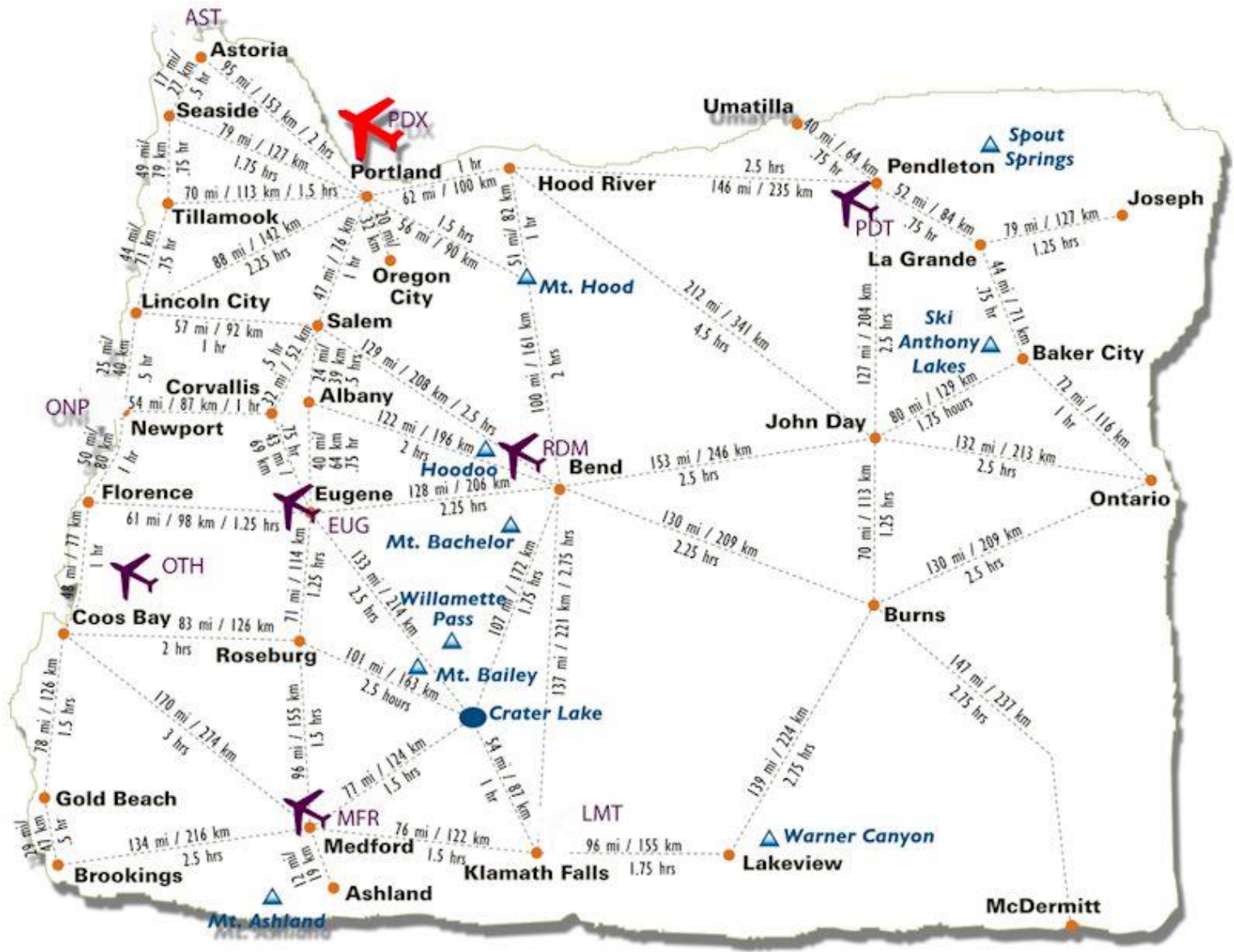
Aviation in Oregon

- 97 Public Use Airports
- 350 privately owned airports - many open to public
- 57 FAA funded airports (NIPIAS) 10% - 90%
- 28 owned by State of Oregon-Dept of Aviation
- 12,000 jobs in 78 towns
- \$62,395 average wage
- \$22 Billion economic impact

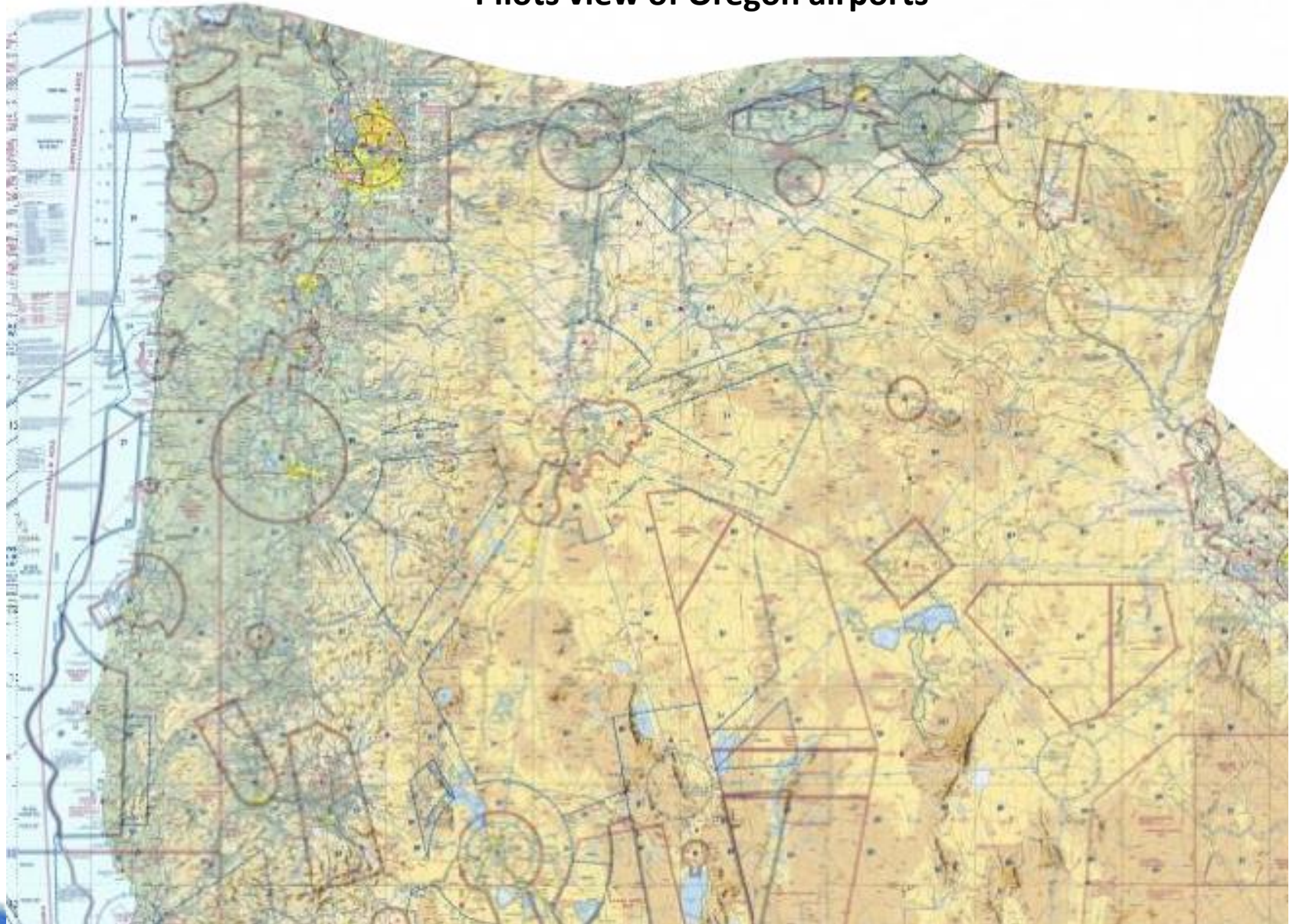
Economic Development - Air transportation



Travelers & skiers view of Oregon Airports

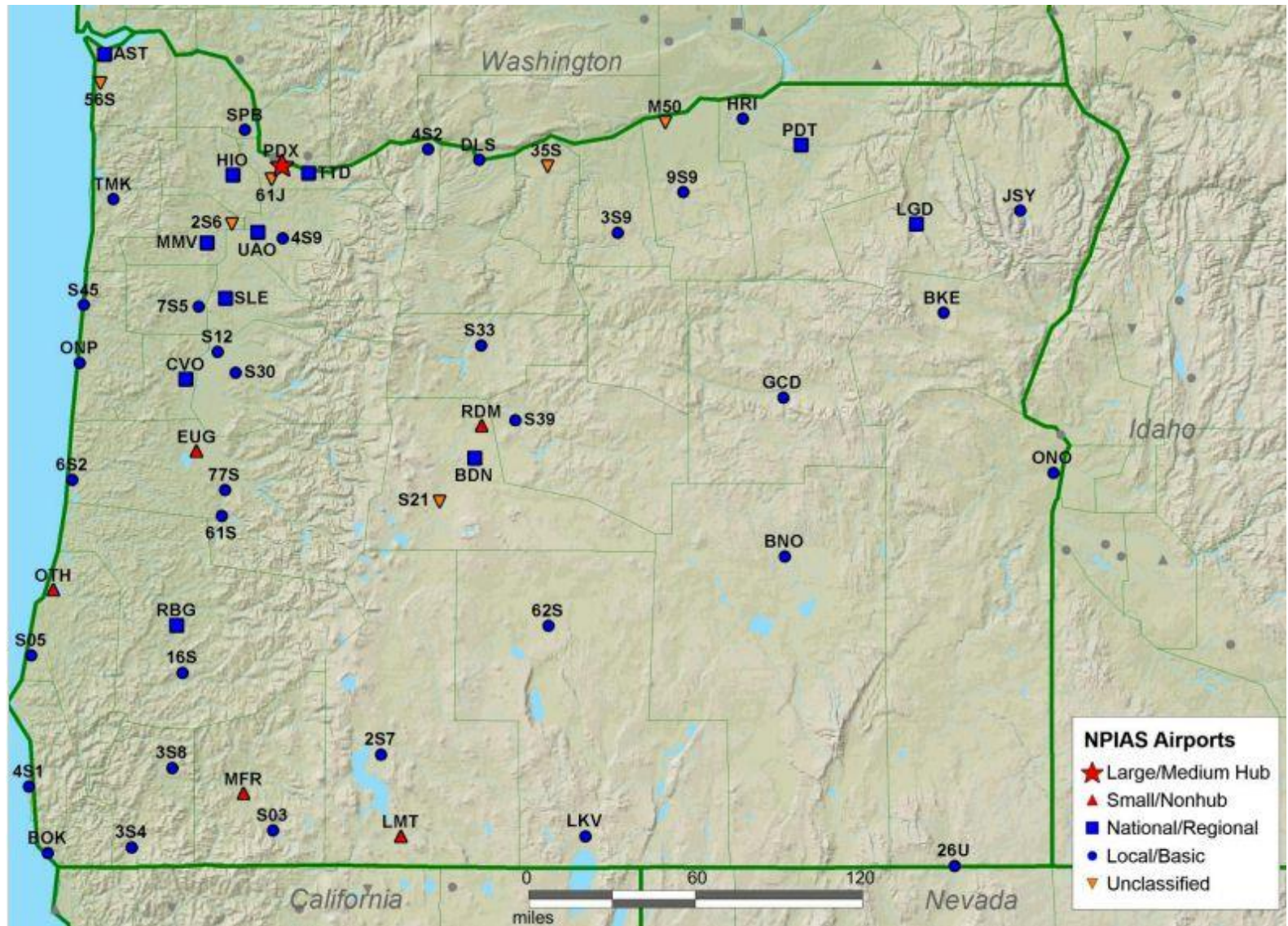


Pilots view of Oregon airports
