**Measure Description:**

Defines "inhalant delivery system." Amends laws concerning sale of tobacco products to, and use of tobacco products by, minors so those laws equally apply to inhalant delivery systems.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Cities, Counties, Department of Corrections, Department of Justice, Judicial Department, Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT), Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Oregon Liquor Control Commission (OLCC)

**Analysis:**

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
