WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Establishes Affordable Baccalaureate Degree Act. Directs public universities and community colleges to work toward providing four-year affordable, fixed-cost baccalaureate degrees. Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC) to analyze available options for affordable degrees and report findings to 2016 Legislative Assembly. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

BACKGROUND: Several states are investigating the possibility of offering fixed-cost degree programs at their public universities in the belief that increasing attendance costs are keeping many potential students from considering college. House Bill 2973-A directs public universities, community colleges and HECC to investigate the possibility of creating such programs in Oregon.
