




Global Trade Can Drive Oregon Small Businesses

- More than 92,000 jobs in Oregon supported by international business
- Companies with international business pay their employees more
- More than 6,000 Oregon companies export
- 88% are small businesses
- Oregon exported \$21 billion last year, the most ever









STEP Grant Program

- Grant reimburses up to \$5,000 at a rate of 50% of eligible expenses, including:
 - Exhibition costs or trade mission fee
 - Per diem (on ground) expenses for one person
- Also available for:
 - Export training, distributor search services, market research, Website translation
- Reimbursed after event and report completed and receipts submitted

STEP Grant Process

- 1:1 counseling with our Global Trade team on export strategy
- Determine if additional export strategy development is needed, or ready to move forward with grant program
- Identify right foreign event opportunity, apply for grant



STEP Grant Eligibility

• Small business:

- U.S. SBA requirement of under 500 employees
- not a subsidiary of a large company

• Oregon business:

• at least 75% of firm's total employees in Oregon


Activity must be international

- U.S. events approved on an exceptional basis

• Agree to report results




Oregon's STEP Performance






STEP Year 1 Participating Firms and Reported Export Sales






STEP Year 2 Participating Firms and Reported Export Sales
