7	Whereas Specialist Mabry James Anders joined the United States Army,
8	4th Special Troops Battalion, 4th Brigade Combat Team, 4th Infantry Divi-
9	sion out of Fort Carson, Colorado, on January 5, 2010, and became an Army
10	Specialist; and
11	Whereas Specialist Mabry James Anders was deployed on a tour of duty
12	to Afghanistan in March 2010 and became a wheeled vehicle mechanic after
13	his military education, which included the Light-Wheel Vehicle Mechanic
14	course, the Route Reconnaissance and Clearance Maintainer course and the
15	Combat Lifesaver course; and

17	27, 2012, by small arms enemy fire in Kalagush, Afghanistan; and
