Department of Aviation

HB 5004 is the budget bill for the Department of Aviation. The department promotes, develops, and improves Oregon's aviation system. It manages and maintains 28 state-owned airports, performs safety inspections of Oregon's 97 public-use airports, and registers all pilots and non-military aircraft based in Oregon. The agency is supported by aviation fuel taxes and pilot, aircraft, and airport registration fees.

The Transportation and Economic Development subcommittee recommends a budget of \$6,178,432 Other Funds and \$3,434,014 Federal Funds for a total biennial budget of \$9.66 million, including 13 positions or 12.25 full-time equivalent jobs. The Subcommittee also recommends adoption of the agency's Key Performance Measures as presented.

The Transportation and Economic Development subcommittee recommends HB 5004 be amended by the -1 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
