Measure Description:

Includes Oregon nonprofit corporations as public employer for purposes of transfers of certain public employees.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Bureau of Labor and Industries (BOLI), Employment Relations Board, Department of Administrative Services (DAS), Public Employees Retirement System (PERS), Higher Education Coordinating Commission, Oregon Health Sciences University (OHSU), SAIF (State Accident Insurance Fund)

Analysis:
