- Continuing Education Seminars – 1-2 day courses



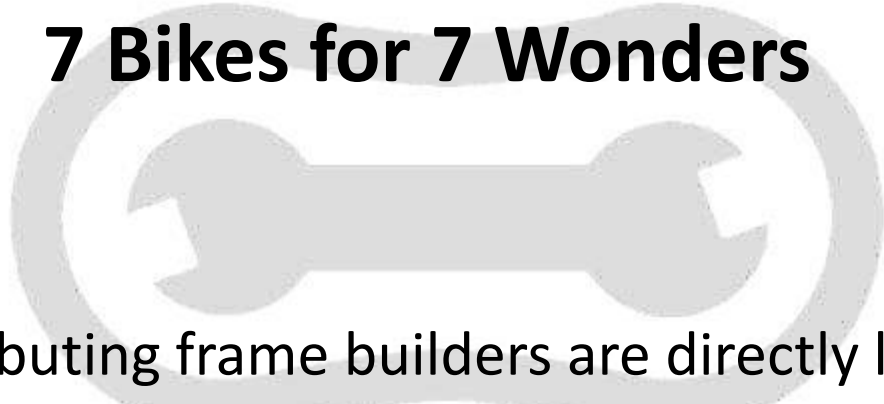
# Bicycle Frame Building Program

- TIG Welding Seminar – 2 day course

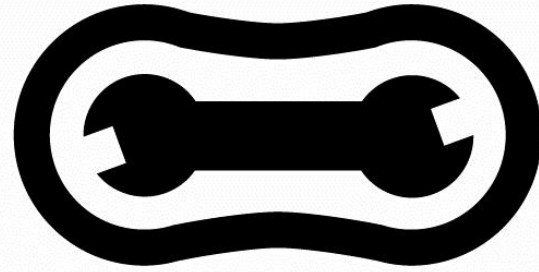


# Travel Oregon 7 Bikes for 7 Wonders
