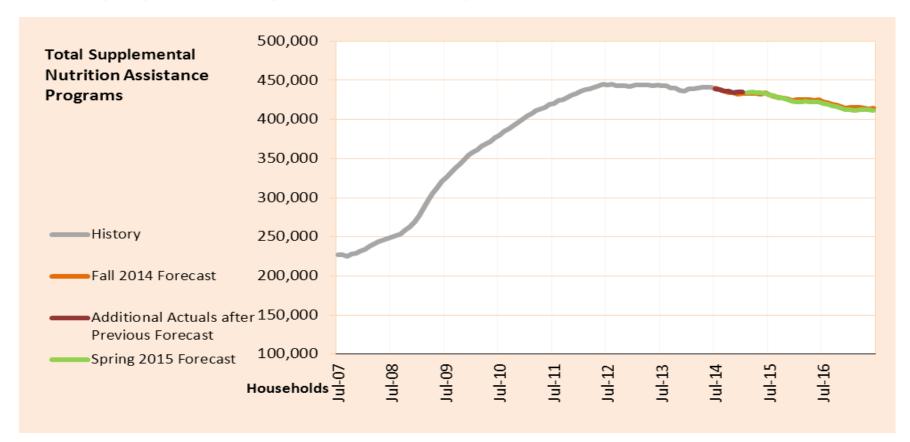

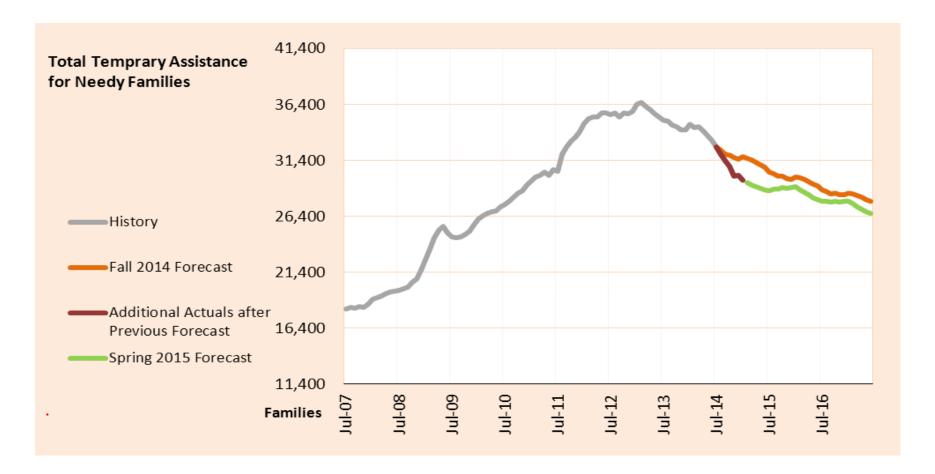

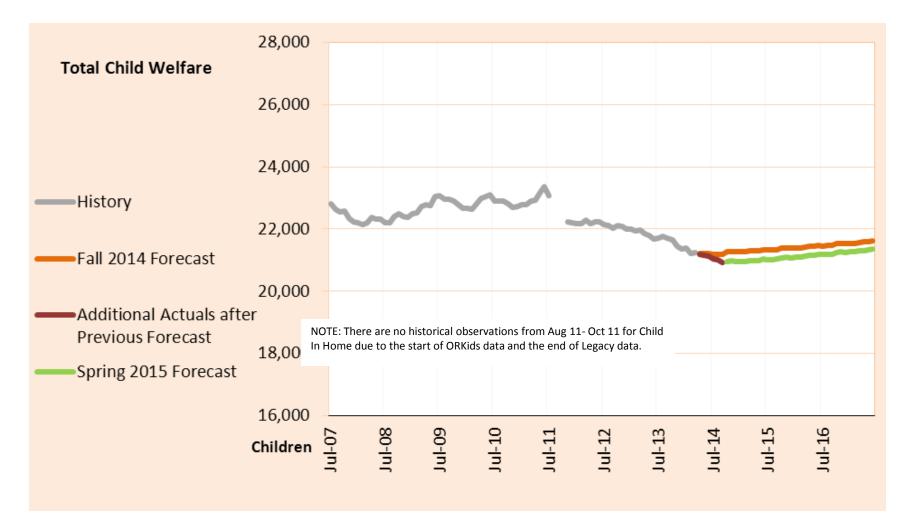


## **TANF Caseload Overview**



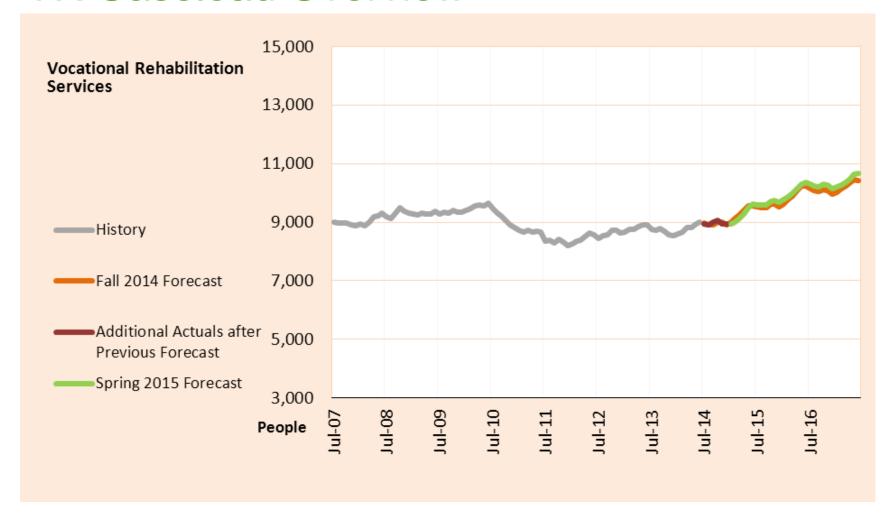


### Child Welfare Caseload Overview



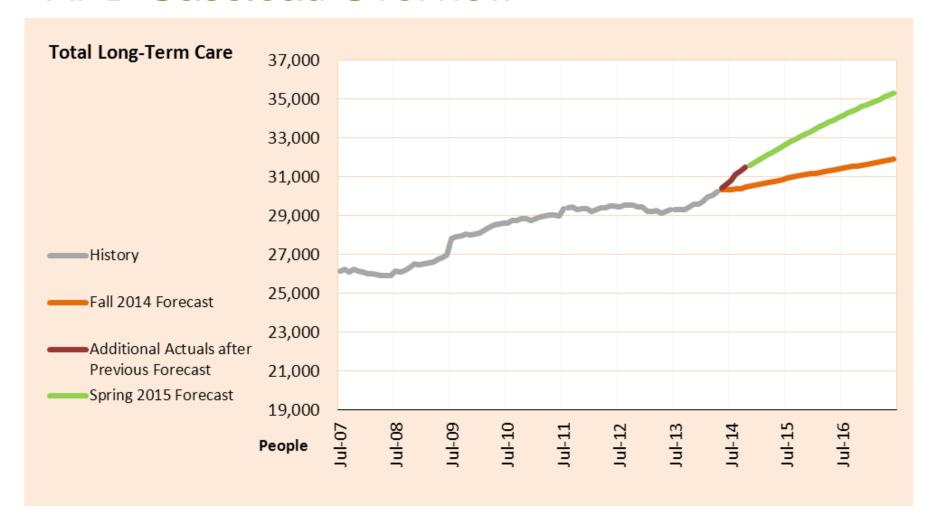


## **VR Caseload Overview**



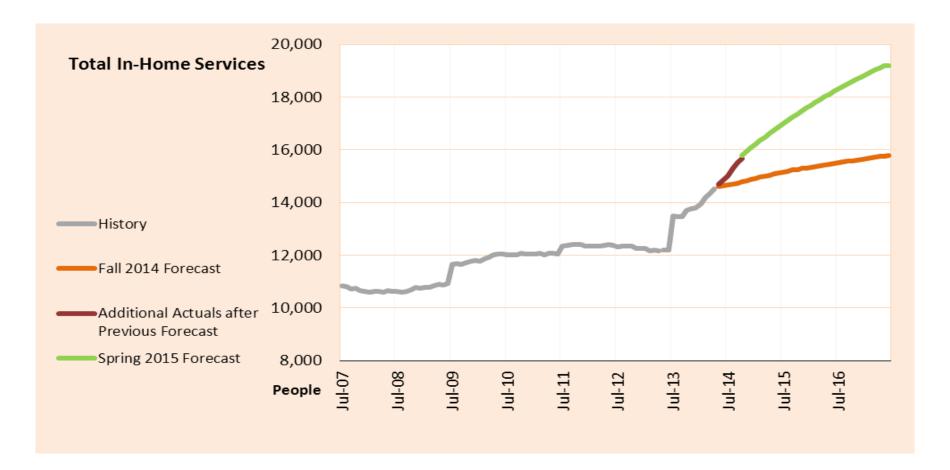

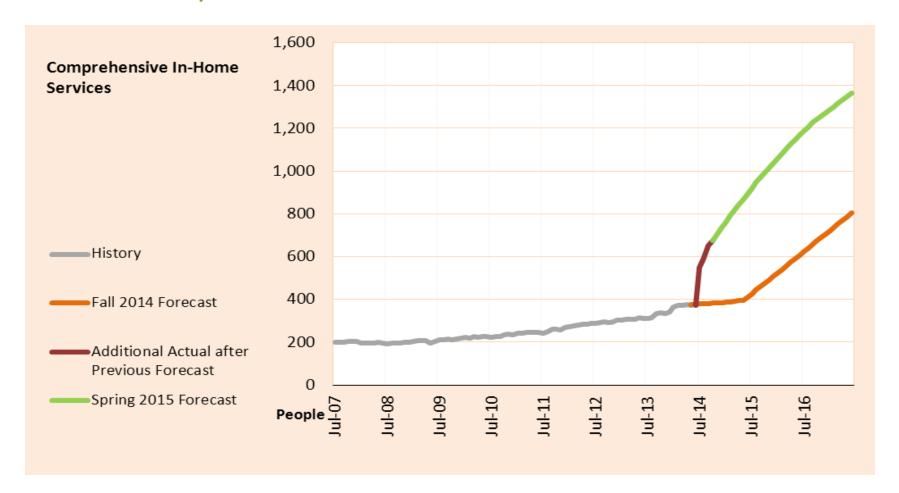


### Total In-Home Services Caseload Overview

## **Overview of Program Reshoot Cost Changes**

#### **SS**: (\$13.9) Million GF

Decrease in Caseload (Spring Forecast)

#### CW: \$7.9 Million GF

Slight Caseload/Cost per case increase in Permanency (Spring Forecast)
Slight Decrease in Caseload/Cost per case in Well Being (Spring Forecast)
Workload increase due to increase in assessments causing a shift in work type
Increase in Federal Match due to change in FMAP

#### **VR**: No Changes

#### APD: \$32.4 Million GF

Case load and cost per case increases (Spring Forecast)
Workload increase due to increased caseloads (Spring Forecast)
Nursing Facility decrease from GB due to lower cost reports
Increase in Federal Match due to change in FMAP

#### I/DD: \$18.1 Million GF

Case load and cost per case increases (Spring Forecast)
Workload increase due to increased caseloads (Spring Forecast)
Increase in Federal Match due to change in FMAP
