Measure Description:

Prohibits shipment or transportation of cigarettes, or smokeless tobacco products to anyone within state unless a distributor or retailer. Requires face-to-face transactions for retail sale of tobacco products. Provides civil action enforcement authority to Attorney General. Allows execution of investigative demand by Attorney General for purposes of investigating violations of Act.

Revenue Impact (in \$Millions): Minimal

Impact Explanation:

The measure is expected to have a minimal impact upon revenue. Similar requirements and civil action enforcement authorities exist at the federal level.
