**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Permits Oregon Department of Transportation to renew or replace out-of-state service member’s driver’s license without photograph.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:**

**BACKGROUND:** Existing edict requires a photograph on a driver’s license, with only two permissive exceptions.

Senate Bill 494 allows a third, narrow, permissive allowance to the photograph requirement: only for renewal or replacement licenses, for service members stationed outside Oregon, who do not have an acceptable photograph on file with the Oregon Department of Transportation.
