**Subject:** HB 2228A-Engrossed, relating to retention of fingerprint information

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HB 2228A-Eng requires the Oregon State Police (OSP) to establish a voluntary fingerprint retention program through which OSP would retain fingerprint cards and facsimiles of fingerprints received from the Federal Bureau of Investigation, or created during a state criminal records check. These records would be made available to agencies or districts subscribing to the voluntary fingerprint retention program. The bill required the Department of Administrative Services to adopt rules for program administration, and permits OSP to adopt a program subscription fee.

The measure, the original staff measure summary, a preliminary Joint Committee on Ways and Means staff measure summary, fiscal impact statement, and measure history are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS).

**LFO recommends the measure be moved to the full Joint Committee on Ways and Means.**
