Measure Description:

Adds Oregon Volunteer Firefighters Association to list of entities eligible for individual income tax return checkoff contribution.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Revenue (DOR), Legislative Administration Committee (LAC), Legislative Assembly

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Revenue to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill creates the Task Force on Charitable Checkoffs and specifies the membership and duties of the Task Force. It is anticipated that there may be a fiscal impact associated with this bill, but the amount of the impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is further considered.
