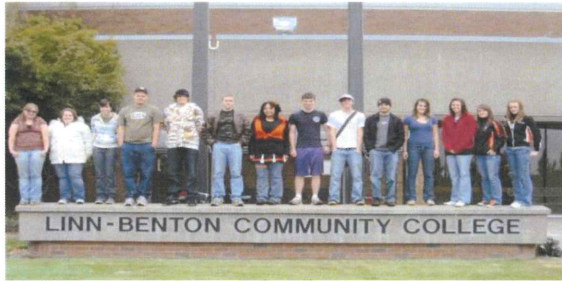

The PACE Program



The PACE Plan

The PACE Plan provides students with opportunities to attend and earn credits from Scio High School and Linn-Benton Community College or Chemeketa Community College or other state colleges. The Scio School District pays for tuition and books.

Who Qualifies?

High School Students in the Scio School District may qualify for the PACE program.

What are the requirements?

Students must:

- Have a cumulative minimum 3.0 GPA.
- Complete and pass all required state tests and essential skills .
- Complete and pass the Mentor/Mentee class.
- Submit PACE application.
- Pass the PACE interview process.
- Students receive Scio High School diploma at the completion of their PACE program plan.



What are the benefits?

Students have the opportunity to attend a community college full time or they may choose to go to college part time and high school part time. They can acquire their Oregon Transfer Module or a Certificate. Most college credits transfer to a four year university. College credits can be used towards required high school credits.

Advantages:

- Smooth transition from high school to college.
- Establishes good credentials for higher education or the job market.
- Opportunity to make progress towards college degree.
