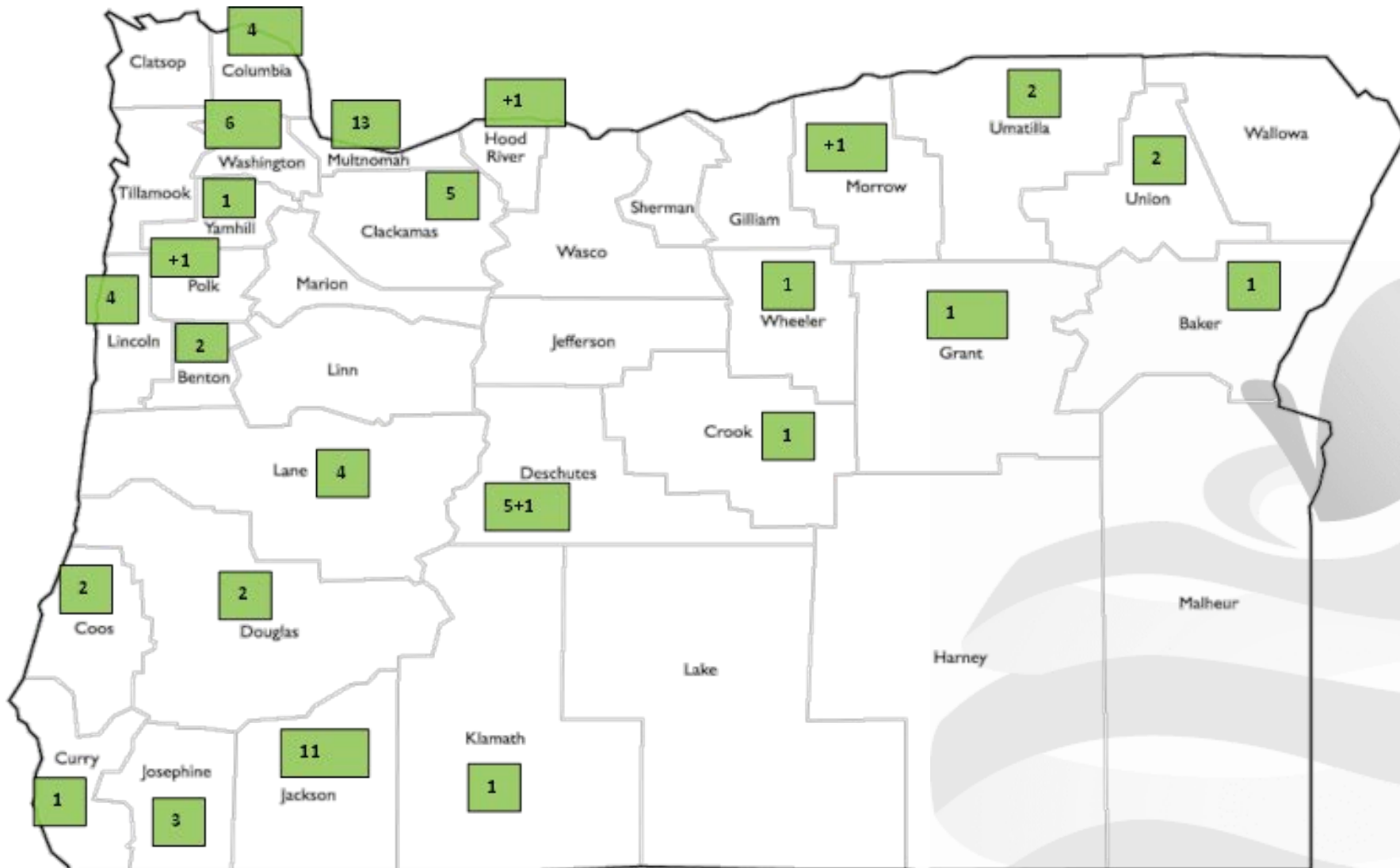

SBHCs in Oregon (2013-2014)

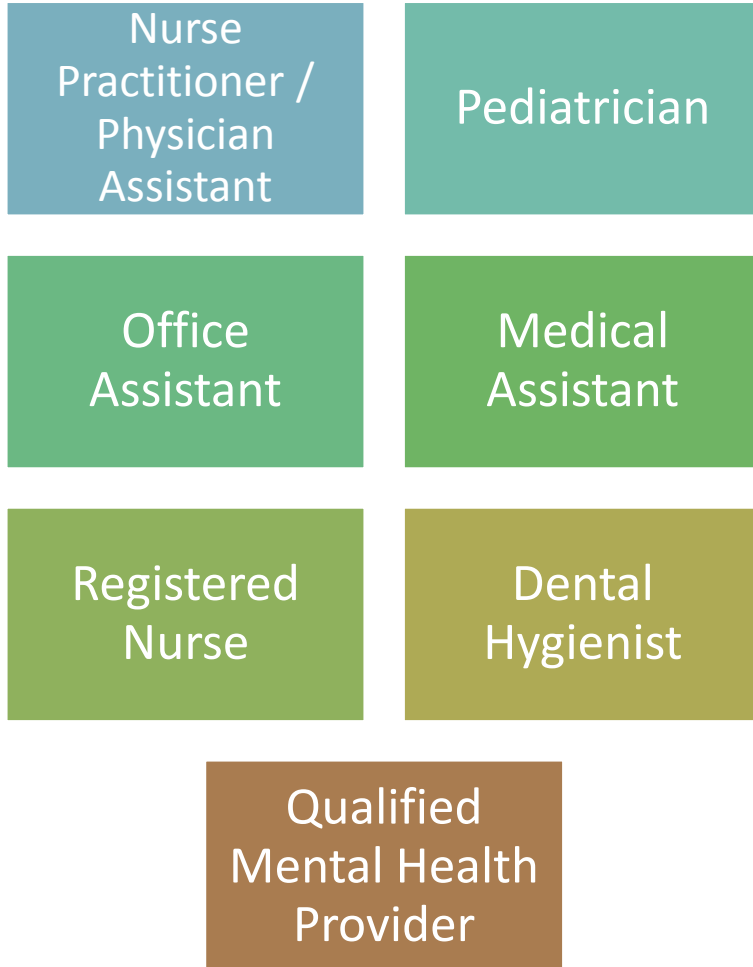
72% of SBHCs sponsored by

LPHAs

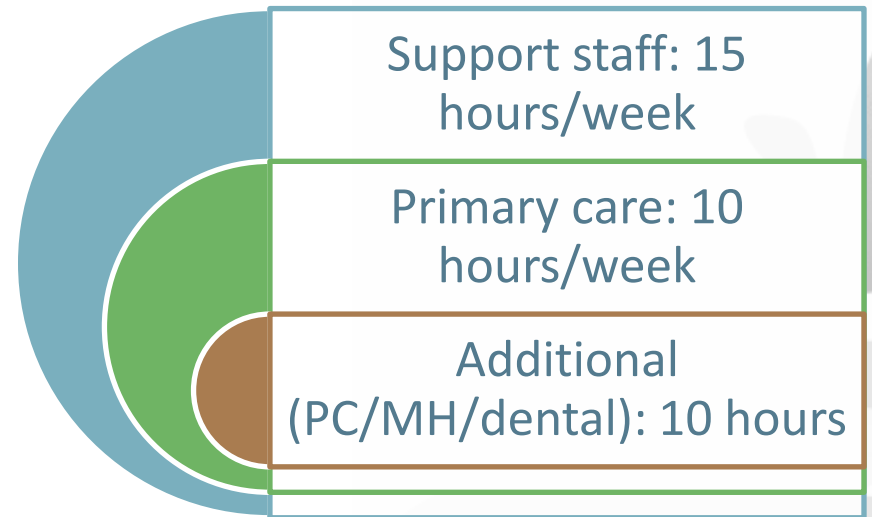
