Measure Description:

Allows establishment of one or more predator damage control districts (District) within county to fund county services to prevent, reduce and mitigate damage to property from predatory animals.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Agriculture, Department of Forestry, Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW)

Analysis:
