**The revenue impact of this measure is indeterminate for the following reasons:**

The measure allows for the establishment of predator damage control districts, the revenues from which would be used to support mitigation of damage to livestock or property from predatory animals. The permanent tax rate would be set at \$1 per acre, or \$25 for an owner of land that is on a tax lot of less than 10 acres or for an owner of land greater than 10 acres in some cases. These amounts can be changed by the advisory board with the approval of the county. The revenue from the establishment of these districts is unknown and would depend on the number of districts, the size of the assessment, and the acreage in the districts.
