

HB 3100

Relating to public health

HB 3100 restructures the framework for how public health services are provided to Oregonians. The bill requires the Oregon Health Authority to adopt and update a statewide public health modernization assessment, and to establish the foundational capabilities necessary to protect and improve the health of residents of this state. Local public health authorities will work with the Oregon Health Authority to develop local plans for implementation.

A total of \$500,000 General Fund is included in the budget for the Oregon Health Authority to cover the planning and assessment activities required by this bill.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends HB 3100 be reported out do pass.
