

SB 875

Relating to adrenal insufficiency

SB 875 requires the State Board of Education to adopt rules regarding which school personnel may administer medications that treat adrenal insufficiency, to students experiencing adrenal crisis.

The Joint Committee on Ways and Means previously approved this bill, and it has passed the Senate.

The -A2 amendment clarifies that the definition for “medication” as used in SB 875 means medication available for treating adrenal insufficiency, to resolve conflicts with HB 3041.

I recommend SB 875 be amended by the -A2 conflict amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
