

HB 2411

Relating to the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission

HB 2411 makes changes to the licensing structure of the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission. It reduces the overall number of licenses to a more manageable number reflecting the work of a licensure redesign committee made up a wide cross section of educators and other stakeholders.

The Joint Committee on Ways and Means previously approved this bill, and it has passed the House.

The -B3 amendment clarifies the language between this bill and HB 2412 which removed outdated provisions and updated terminology relating to teachers.

I recommend HB 2411 be amended by the -B3 conflict amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
