

HB 2002

Relating to public safety

HB 2002 defines profiling and requires law enforcement agencies to have written policies prohibiting profiling by January 1, 2016. It establishes the Law Enforcement Contacts and Policy Data Review Committee as a repository for profiling complaints. The Review Committee will be housed at Portland State University. The cost for this work is \$250,431 General Fund.

The bill also establishes a 10-member work group, staffed by the Department of Justice. The work group is to prepare a report concerning profiling, including recommendations for legislation. There is no additional cost for this staffing.

The Public Safety Subcommittee recommends HB 2002 be amended by the -A6 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
