

HB 2205

Relating to child victims of commercial sexual exploitation

HB 2205 establishes the Fund to End Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children.

The Department of Justice is to administer the fund and may solicit and accept contributions from both public and private sources for deposit into the fund.

DOJ is to establish an advisory committee to advise the department on recommendations for the distribution of monies from the fund.

DOJ may require Other Funds expenditure limitation in order to expend monies from the fund once contributions are received.

The Public Safety Subcommittee recommends HB 2205 be reported out do pass.
