HB 3059 A would require the Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor and Industries to implement and maintain a toll-free line to receive inquires and complaints related to employment in the performance of live entertainment. The toll-free line would be required to be staffed by certified social workers or individuals who have a background in providing live entertainment as an independent contractor.
