

HB 3525

Relates to obstructing governmental administration

HB 3525 creates the 12-member Task Force on Immigration Consultant Fraud required to study violations by immigration consultants and the obstruction of persons attempting to report violations of immigration consultants. The task force is directed to report back to the Legislature by September 15, 2015.

There is a minimal fiscal impact to the Oregon Advocacy Commissions Office to provide support for the task force.

The General Government Subcommittee recommends HB 3525 be reported out do pass.
