HB 5025 Higher Education Coordinating Commission – fee bill

HB 5025 will ratify new fees for the State Authorization Reciprocity Agreement as well as increase fees associated with the Private Career Schools unit within the Higher Education Coordinating Commission.

These fees are anticipated to generate additional revenue in the amount of \$264,750 Other Funds in the 2015-17 biennium, which will support the addition of one new Educational Specialist 2 position as well as the reclassifications of three other existing positions. These fees have been assumed in the Higher Education Coordinating Commission budget bill (HB 5024).

The Subcommittee recommends adoption of an amendment which corrects fee amounts that were incorrectly printed in the introduced version of the bill.

The Education Subcommittee recommends HB 5025 be amended by the -1 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
