SB 416 Relating to imposition of fees on entities subject to the Oregon Indoor Clean Air Act

SB 416 requires smoke shops to pay a certification fee to the Oregon Health Authority. Certifications must be renewed every five years. Smoke shops are currently certified, but do not pay a fee. Instead, the costs of certification come out of funding dedicated for tobacco prevention and education.

The fiscal impact of the bill is expected to be minimal. The agency anticipates certifying or renewing certifications for about 14 smoke shops per biennium.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends SB 416 be reported out do pass.
