

HB 2270

Relating to seismic resilience planning

HB 2270 creates the office of State Resilience Officer within the Office of the Governor to direct, implement and coordinate seismic safety and resilience goal setting and state agency planning and preparation for this purpose. The bill also specifies that both the legislative and judicial branches must identify an individual to monitor the effectiveness of seismic safety resilience and planning for their respective branches.

The Subcommittee recommends a General Fund appropriation of \$304,653 for the Office of the Governor to support two positions, the State Resilience Officer and an executive support specialist to fulfill the requirements of the measure.

The General Government Subcommittee recommends HB 2270 be amended by the -3 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
