Work Session Recommendation

HB 5039 is the allocation bill for the Tobacco Master Settlement Agreement revenues. These revenues are transferred from the Tobacco Settlement Funds Account in the Department of Administrative Services. The original bill contains the transfers consistent with the Governor's budget. The -1 amendment results in the following transfers:

- \$30,909,888 for the DAS, Oregon Health and Science Bond Fund
- \$101,760,000 to the Oregon Health Authority for the Oregon Health Plan
- \$16,000,000 to the Oregon Health Authority for community mental health programs
- \$4,120,000 to the Oregon Health Authority for tobacco prevention and cessation programs
- \$4,120,000 to the Oregon Department of Education for physical education-related grants
