Work Session Recommendations

HB 2668 relates to industrial hemp. The measure prohibits the Department of Agriculture from issuing industrial hemp or hemp seed production licenses if the operation is within 1,000 feet of a school. The Department is directed to rescind current licenses for growers within 1,000 feet of a school and to provide just compensation if the grower incurred costs prior to revocation. The Department's initial estimate for just compensation is assumed to be \$500-\$750 per acre.

The measure also directs the Department and Oregon State University's College of Agricultural Sciences to conduct research on currently licensed industrial hemp operations for a minimum of one growing season.

The -B14 amendment provides \$100,000 General Fund to the Department of Agriculture for rule-making and to provide just compensation to growers that meet the measures criteria.

The amendment also provides \$290,000 General Fund to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to be used by the Oregon State University College of Agricultural Sciences to conduct the research.

Recommended Changes to HB 2668:

The Legislative Fiscal Office recommends adoption of the -B14 amendment.
