

HB 3100

Relating to public health

HB 3100 restructures the framework for how public health services are provided to Oregonians. The bill requires the Oregon Health Authority to adopt and update a statewide public health modernization assessment, and to establish the foundational capabilities necessary to protect and improve the health of residents of this state.

The Joint Committee on Ways and Means previously approved this bill, and it has passed the House.

The -A4 amendment clarifies the language between this bill and HB 3400 which modified the medical marijuana program.

I recommend HB 3100 be amended by the -A4 conflict amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
