Work Session Recommendations

---

House Bill 2250-A authorizes the Department of Administrative Services to adopt rules related to electronic fingerprint capture services. The measure shifts most of the Clearinghouse program activities from the Oregon State Police to the Department of Human Services.

The work session packet, including the –A10 amendments, is available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS).

## **Amendment**

The –A10 amendment provides further clarification and direction regarding background checks and fitness determinations. The amendment also provides a General Fund appropriation of \$144,705, Other Funds limitations of \$187,768 and \$117,981, and Federal Funds limitation of \$177,000 to the Department of Human Services, and decreases the Other Funds limitation of the Oregon State Police by \$90,049.
