

HB 2730

Relating to transportation

HB 2730 makes changes to ODOT's special registration license plates program. It establishes a specialty license plate program with the department, removes the limit on the number of specialty plates that can be issued at one time, and creates two new special registration license plates: a Portland Trailblazers plate, and a Breast Cancer Awareness plate.

The Joint Committee on Ways and Means previously approved this bill, and it has passed the House.

The -B8 amendment resolves a conflict with SB 943 by removing references to group license plates; and it resolves a conflict with SB 472 by deleting the limit on the number of types of specialty plates that can be issued at one time.

I recommend HB 2730 be amended by the -B8 conflict amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
