SUPPORT SENATE BILL 440 ALIGNMENT OF HEALTH CARE QUALITY METRICS

Establishes a single committee accountable for developing a “menu” of quality measures from which health care purchasers may choose.

- **Aligns quality measures with statewide strategic plan for the collection and use of health care data**

Oregon Health Policy Board, in consultation with OHA, PEBB, OEBC and DCBS, will develop a long-term strategy related to the collection and use of health care data. Plan will be submitted to the legislature by Sept. 1, 2016.

- **Establishes Health Plan Quality Metrics Committee**

A diverse group of stakeholders accountable for developing a single “menu” of quality and incentive measures. Provides high-level framework to ensure effectiveness and alignment with state strategy.

- **Aligns purchasing across state payers to leverage public resources**

Requires OHA, CCOs, PEBB, OEBC and DCBS to select quality measures from the “menu” developed by the Committee. Bill does not require that they adopt all of the measures developed.



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
