SUMMARY

Authorizes establishment of firearms training facility on lot or parcel that is in exclusive farm zone, forest zone or mixed farm and forest zone, and that is not within city or urban growth boundary.

Relating to firearms training facilities.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 215.

SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, "firearms training facility" means an indoor or outdoor facility that provides firearms-related training courses and issues firearm-related certifications that are required:

(a) For law enforcement personnel;

(b) By the State Department of Fish and Wildlife; or

(c) By nationally recognized programs that promote shooting matches, target shooting and gun safety.

(2) A county may approve a firearms training facility as a conditional use on a lot or parcel that is:

(a) In an exclusive farm use zone, a forest zone or a mixed farm and forest zone; and

(b) Not within the corporate boundaries of a city or within an urban growth boundary.

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter *[italic and bracketed]* is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
