**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 5507**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 4, before the semicolon
2 insert “, section 7, chapter ____, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled Senate Bill 113),
3 sections 19, 20 and 21, chapter 537, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled Senate Bill
4 454), section 17, chapter ____, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled Senate Bill 478),
5 section 12, chapter 557, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 2960), section
6 1, chapter ____, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 5022), and section 3,
7 chapter ____, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 5040)”.

8 Delete lines 10 through 16 and insert:

9 “**NOTE:** Section 2 was deleted by amendment. Subsequent sections were
10 not renumbered.”.

11 On page 5, delete lines 29 through 36 and insert:

12 “**NOTE:** Section 35 was deleted by amendment. Subsequent sections were
13 not renumbered.”.

6 **creased by \$768,000 for the expenses of implementing the motor voter**
7 **provisions of chapter 8, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 2177).**

8 **SECTION 126. If Senate Bill 478 becomes law, section 17, chapter**
9 **___, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled Senate Bill 478), is repealed.**

10 **SECTION 127. Sections 19, 20 and 21, chapter 537, Oregon Laws 2015**
11 **(Enrolled Senate Bill 454), are repealed.**

12 **SECTION 128. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the**
13 **General Fund appropriation made to the Department of Environ-**
14 **mental Quality by section 1 (1), chapter 593, Oregon Laws 2015 (En-**
15 **rolled House Bill 5018), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, for air**
16 **quality, is decreased by \$778,141 for expenses of implementing the low**
17 **carbon fuel standards under chapter 4, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled**
18 **Senate Bill 324).**

19 **SECTION 129. Section 12, chapter 557, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled**
20 **House Bill 2960), is repealed.**

21 **SECTION 130. Section 7, chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled**
22 **Senate Bill 113), is repealed.**

23 **SECTION 131. Section 1, chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled**
24 **House Bill 5022), is repealed.**

25 **SECTION 132. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the**
26 **General Fund appropriation made to the Department of Human Ser-**
27 **vices by section 1 (1), chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House**
28 **Bill 5026), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, is decreased by**
29 **\$831,865 for the expenses of implementing the REAL+D project to de-**
30 **sign, build and implement a tool to collect, report and analyze data**

1 on race, ethnicity, language and disability.

2 **“SECTION 133.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
3 General Fund appropriation made to the Oregon Health Authority by
4 section 1 (1), chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5526),
5 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, is decreased by \$634,672 for
6 expenses of implementing the REAL+D project to design, build and
7 implement a tool to collect, report and analyze data on race, ethnicity,
8 language and disability.

9 **“SECTION 134.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
10 General Fund appropriation made to the State Library by section 1,
11 chapter 407, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5519), for the
12 biennium beginning July 1, 2015, is decreased by \$4,602,951 for the State
13 Library Government Research and Electronic Service Program.

14 **“SECTION 135.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
15 General Fund appropriation made to the Department of Justice by
16 section 1 (2), chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5516),
17 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, for the Civil Enforcement
18 Division, is decreased by \$2,000,000 for the Cover Oregon litigation.

19 **“SECTION 136.** Section 3, chapter ___, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled
20 House Bill 5040), is repealed.

21 **“SECTION 137. (1)** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
22 General Fund appropriation made to the Department of Environ-
23 mental Quality by section 1 (1), chapter 593, Oregon Laws 2015 (En-
24 rolled House Bill 5018), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, for air
25 quality, is decreased by \$361,563 for extending an air toxics study on
26 Swan Island.

27 **“(2)** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund
28 appropriation made to the Department of Environmental Quality by
29 section 1 (2), chapter 593, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 5018),
30 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, for water quality, is decreased

1 by \$452,719 for a new wastewater permitting software module to re-
2 place the current system.

3 “(3) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund
4 appropriation made to the Department of Environmental Quality by
5 section 1 (2), chapter 593, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 5018),
6 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, for water quality, is decreased
7 by \$491,435 for water quality assessment.

8 “(4) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund
9 appropriation made to the Department of Environmental Quality by
10 section 1 (2), chapter 593, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 5018),
11 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, for water quality, is decreased
12 by \$403,568 for nonpoint source pollution.

13 “(5) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund
14 appropriation made to the Department of Environmental Quality by
15 section 1 (3), chapter 593, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 5018),
16 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, for land quality, is decreased
17 by \$675,849 for the promotion and enhancement of waste reduction and
18 recycling.

19 “(6) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund
20 appropriation made to the Department of Environmental Quality by
21 section 1 (2), chapter 593, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 5018),
22 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, for water quality, is decreased
23 by \$1,098,213 for management reforms.

24 “SECTION 138. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
25 General Fund appropriation made to the Oregon Department of Ad-
26 ministrative Services by section 1 (4), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2015
27 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5502), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, is
28 decreased by \$375,000 for the Oregon Historical Society.

29 “SECTION 139. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate
30 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is

1 **declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**

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
