Measure Description:

Permits State Apprenticeship and Training Council to make exceptions to apprentice wage schedule, and to minimum numeric ratio of journeymen to apprentices, to further operation of apprenticeship and training programs in Oregon Youth Authority institutions.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Bureau of Labor and Industries (BOLI), Oregon Youth Authority (OYA)

Analysis:

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
