Measure Description:

Requires organizer to obtain permit from State Forestry Department prior to conducting large commercial event on state forestlands.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Forestry, Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Oregon Health Authority (OHA)

Analysis:
