**Measure Description:**

Requires applicant for license, tag or permit to angle, take, hunt or trap to attest that applicant consents to inspection of license, tag or permit and taken wildlife.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW)

**Summary of Expenditure Impact:**

**Local Government Mandate:**

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

**Analysis:** This bill would require an applicant for a license to angle, take, hunt, or trap to consent to inspection of the license document. The proof of attestation is required to be printed on the license and to be signed by the applicant.

This additional information would require an additional 2.5” of paper space per document. There would be 1.3 million documents affected. This could mean an additional 50 miles or more of paper per year. Paper is included in transaction fees charged by the contractor that runs the point of sale system and would not have a direct effect on the agency.
