Measure Description:

Requires community colleges and public universities to establish priority enrollment system for qualified students who are active members of Armed Forces of the United States or qualified veterans.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Higher Education Coordinating Commission

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Veterans and Emergency Preparedness to the House Committee On Higher Education, Innovation, and Workforce Development. The bill requires community colleges and public universities to establish priority enrollment for qualified students who are active members of Armed Forces. A fiscal impact associated with this bill is anticipated; however the scope of that impact will vary between institutions based on current enrollment practices and the number or ratio of veterans seeking enrollment for each institution. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the House Committee On Higher Education, Innovation, and Workforce Development.
