Measure Description:

Changes name of Teacher Standards and Practices Commission to Professional Educator Standards Board.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Teacher Standards and Practices Commission, Department of Education

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee On Higher Education, Innovation, and Workforce Development to the House Committee on Education. The bill changes the name of Teacher Standards and Practices Commission to Professional Educator Standards Board. As well as updates terms for teacher education programs and makes changes to licensure structure for teachers and administrators. Increases maximum amount allowed for fees for issuance of license. This bill may have an associated fiscal impact; the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the House Committee on Education.
