Measure Description: Extends the sunset date for the Working Family Child Care tax credit from January 1, 2016 to January 1, 2022.

Impact Explanation: The preliminary revenue impact provided here is based on the historical use of the tax credit. In recent years (2009 to 2012) the use of this tax credit was very stable at just over 25,000 full-year claimants annually. The cost of the credit was equally stable at just under \$22 million annually. Further analysis will be done when the bill is in the Joint Committee on Tax Credits.
