Measure Description:

Establishes Outdoor Education Account for purpose of providing outdoor school programs.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Higher Education Coordinating Commission

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Education to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill establishes the Outdoor Education Account and appropriates \$44 million General Fund to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services for deposit in the account. There is a fiscal impact associated with this bill. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
