Measure Description:

Authorizes Department of State Police and State Fire Marshal to accept and distribute gifts, grants, donations and funds from any source, including services and property, to carry out duties of department or marshal.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon State Police (OSP)

Summary of Expenditure Impact: See Analysis

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

The measure allows Oregon State Police and the State Fire Marshal to accept and distribute gifts, grants, donations and funds from any source, including services and property, to carry out the duties of the department or fire marshal.

The fiscal impact is indeterminate. The source and amount of funds available from the potential sources listed in the measure are unknown. If funding is identified, OSP would likely need to return to the Legislature for additional Other Funds limitation in order to receive and distribute the monies.
